**SACRAMENTS**

Baptism – Parishioners wishing to have a child baptized should be registered in the parish and should contact a member of the clergy as early as 3 months before the birth of their child.

First Penance and Eucharist – Normally received in the second grade. Parents should contact the Director of Religious Education (DRE). Enrollment in Religious Education classes is required for at least two years leading up to reception of the sacraments.

Confirmation – Normally received in the 7th grade. Parents should contact the DRE. Enrollment in Religious Education classes is required for at least two years leading up to reception of the sacrament.

RCIA/Adult Confirmation – Adults interested in becoming Catholic or in need of the sacrament of Confirmation should contact the parish office or a member of the clergy.

Matrimony – A minimum of six months preparation is required. Contact the pastor for information regarding scheduling and preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – Please contact the Pastor to inform him of anyone who is homebound, shut-in, or is in the hospital and in need of Holy Communion or anointing.

## ANNOUNCEMENTS

**PARISH BAZAAR:** Our annual bazaar will be on **Sunday, October 29**. The meal this year will be smothered steak with all the fix'ins. The meal will be served beginning at 10:30am and concluding at 1pm. All proceeds from the annual bazaar go toward the payment of multi-peril insurance which is usually around \$27,000/year.

The **M. Lavon Brosseau** estate has established the **M. Lavon and Jack R.
