SACRAMENTS

Baptism – Parishioners wishing to have a child baptized should be registered in the parish and should contact a member of the clergy as early as 3 months before the birth of their child.

First Penance and Eucharist – Normally received in the second grade. Parents should contact the Director of Religious Education (DRE). Enrollment in Religious Education classes is required for at least two years leading up to reception of the sacraments.

Confirmation – Normally received in the 7th grade. Parents should contact the DRE. Enrollment in Religious Education classes is required for at least two years leading up to reception of the sacrament.

RCIA/Adult Confirmation – Adults interested in becoming Catholic or in need of the sacrament of Confirmation should contact the parish office or a member of the clergy.

Matrimony – A minimum of six months preparation is required. Contact the pastor for information regarding scheduling and preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – Please contact the Pastor to inform him of anyone who is homebound, shut-in, or is in the hospital and in need of Holy Communion or anointing.

I want to express my gratitude as well as speak a word of profound thanks on behalf of those who suffered immense losses following the tornadic winds (70-90 mph) and baseball-size hail of the August 10th storm. Once the storm had passed I stepped outside where I found myself overwhelmed by the damage all around me. The roof of every home in Wakeeney was destroyed and 900 vehicles were totaled! With assistance from the Priests Council Aid Fund, a grant from Catholic Charities U.S.A., Trego County Emergency Management, the local Ministerial Alliance, and generous donations from parishes such as yours, those individuals who were suffering received the help they needed. Christ the King Parish of Wakeeney has full replacement insurance coverage and was not a recipient of any of these funds. Your donations were used only for victims in our Diocese with inadequate or no means to repair their damages. Your incredible response is truly heartwarming.
