



## PASTOR MESSAGE

Dear Friends in Christ,

When I conclude the recitation of the Rosary, I have a list of Saints, Blessed, and Venerable that I remember, praying for their intercession. The 3 titles are the steps in the Canonization process where a person becomes a saint.

One of the Venerable, Servants of God, whose intercession I seek is Archbishop Fulton J Sheen. Truly a man of God and a pioneer in evangelization through the mediums of radio and television.

The year 2019 marks two observances of Archbishop Sheen. The first is that Archbishop Sheen was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Peoria, Illinois, September 20, 1919, so 100 years ago. Secondly, Archbishop Sheen died December 9, 1979, 40 years ago.

The Diocese of Peoria opened his cause for canonization in 2002. His heroic virtue and life of sanctity were recognized in 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI and he was given the title “Venerable.” Shortly after that, the canonization process was put on hold because of legal matters.

Since the Diocese of Peoria began the canonization process, the earthly remains of Archbishop Sheen needed to be in the diocese. However, his will stated that he would be interred in New York City. Archbishop Sheen’s closest living relative, a niece, petitioned the New York court system for a transfer in 2016. The Archdiocese of New York tried to block the transfer because they were following the wishes of the Archbishop. Just recently, the Archdiocese’s appeal was blocked, and the earthly remains of Archbishop Sheen were transferred to the Diocese of Peoria. Now, the canonization process has resumed.

This is in God’s time as well because a miracle attributed to Archbishop Sheen’s intercession has been authenticated, which could lead to his beatification, once it is approved by Pope Francis. Let us pray for this process! May God soon raise Archbishop Fulton J Sheen to the altars of sainthood.
